EMBRACING EXCHANGE

In the context of exchanges between German and Dutch designers and artists

Eindhoven designers can be seen during the large furniture exhibition IMM in Cologne

Five Eindhoven designers Daria Biryukova, Anastasia Eggers, Agne Kucerenkaite, Woodjai Lee and Pao Hui Kao take part in the exhibition Embracing Exchange in Cologne during the IMM furniture fair (15-21 January). The exhibition is part of a program to strengthen cultural relations between German and Dutch designers, policy makers and cultural institutions. Leonne Cuppen of Yksi Connect, ambassador of this program, has provided the selection of the Eindhoven designers. Their work can also be seen at Yksi Expo Eindhoven from January 22 through March 18.

The annual IMM furniture fair in Cologne, one of the largest of its kind in Europe, has an ancillary program called 'Passagen Design Week', which takes place partly in the so-called Belgian Viertel, the Belgian district. Two exhibitions take place there as part of the Embracing Exchange program. Southern Treasures shows work by artists and designers from the Mafad Academy in Maastricht. Material designers show work by Dutch designers who focus heavily on materials.
